On behalf of MIT, I would like to give you an update on 90th Anniversary Building project and its needs.

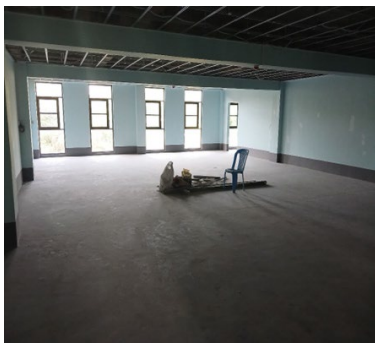
Updates of the progress of 90th Anniversary Building Project
